I-70 Corridor Plan Update – Julio Iturreria

Julio Iturreria updated the map and shared that he is still seeking information for it. He is requesting maps with any known information from all utilities, land owner and projected plans for the area.

Guest Speaker – IREA, Mike LeClair

Mike LeClair from the Strasburg IREA office shared the update on the progress they are making. Over 90 miles of rebuilt lines are completed. The new substations have been built north and south of Bennett. The substation at Strasburg has been rebuilt. They have completed 34 miles of new transmission lines as well.

Guest Speaker –Lend Lease, Krista Sprenger

Bob Loew introduced Krista Sprenger as the spokesperson for Lend Lease. They are still proceeding with their plans for a mixed use development near the I-70 and E470 interchange. The development will feature commercial, residential and industrial development that coexists.
