Are there programs or services the town should plan to provide?

- ◆ Arapahoe County already has services in place that need to be improved and/or provided to the east end of the county without either increased taxes or cutting back. The eastern end should not be discriminated against!
- ◆ Better road maintenance (sic)
- ◆ Better roads, paving rural roads
- ◆ Building the new Byers general store could stimulate the economy out there
- ◆ Byers is in a prime location (1/2 between Limon and Denver). Bring in a truck stop, fast food, and bigger businesses such as Walmart etc.
- ◆ Drinking water is bad
- ◆ Education - more time and effort (sic) to the basics
- ◆ Equestrian center at Quint Valley - indoor arena for public use
- ◆ Family recreation center with pool
- ◆ First and foremost should be incorporation of Byers. From that all the other issues of concern, such as appearance, police/fire services, sense of community/pride, would be addressed.
- ◆ Four-way stop on Hiway 40E and 36 W, accidents have occurred several times
- ◆ Get streets paved. Have Building and Zoning end east of Bennett Kiowa Road.

- ♦ Squandering public funds will always be out of control perhaps form an ethics ways and means committee?
- ♦ Streets and drainage, town street (sic) look like crap. No curb and gutters, poor rain drainage.
- ♦ Teen work program, post ratings of the local dining in the I-70 Scout
- ♦ The town should incorporate
- ♦ The trailer park is an eye sore and a detriment not as a trailer park but how it is maintained and represented as a slum. Low cost housing needs not look like a dump.
- ♦ The train scheduling and overpass thing is extremely important to improving accesability for people and emergency vehicles. Otherwise we all will suffer the consequences sooner or later. We need traffic flow. (sic)
- ♦ We do not need any increased taxes or any cutting back, the east end of Arapahoe should have the same as the west end
- ♦ We need more opportunity for work in this area

### Comments on growth and development issues

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- ♦ A stage needs to be set to keep our talented youth here. Commercial opportunities will help the foundation.
- ♦ Byers does NOT have the tax base to incorporate
- ♦ Byers does not have the tax base to incorporate at this time. We would face higher taxes and lose some county services.
- ♦ Byers is an inexpensive place to live because it is unattractive. Attracting quality residence (sic) and a better commercial base would allow more tax base and yet keep it relatively inexpensive.
- ♦ Byers needs new growth to keep the graduates here
- ♦ CR 181 - 2 houses are \$500,000+ while others have no windows and are falling apart. There should be economic equitable development. (sic)
- ♦ Deertrail come to mind?
- ♦ Developers should be held accountable for there (sic) developments. They survey the property grade a dirt road & enforce no requirements as to how it will be maintained or upkept.
- ♦ Growth has drained ground water, increased crime, brought trash to ditches, and broiught a flood of poorly built houses filled with people who don't care about community, only there (sic) own needs, and ruined small town, I am a 5th generation resident and have much blood and tears invested in area on both sides of family whom (sic) paid taxes here for over 100 years.
- ♦ Growth is a good thing as long as it is aimed in the right direction. People will be more willing to pay for the right kind of developments. They can see what needs to be done; but you have to help it happen!
  
- ♦ I love Byers but am embarrassed by the trash and lack of pride in the appearance of the community. 2 times I needed to call 911 and have a LONG discussion about Adams County vs. Arapahoe County limits - glad I'm still alive.
- ♦ I moved out here for the small town life and to be rid of the city and the troubles that fester there
- ♦ I would like to see Byers remain as rural as possible
- ♦ Incorporaiton is for the birds! We do not need incorporation!
- ♦ Incorporating the town of Byers would move us away from that real country livin - that so many move here for
- ♦ Incorporation would only create additional costs and overhead with very little change to town
- ♦ It might be a good idea to control growth here and not let a bunch of city folks try to tell us what is best for us
- ♦ Keep it rural! Control growth and density!
- ♦ Keep rules and control in our town!
- ♦ Less government control over growth and development. Allow free enterprise to work. Best results in the long term.
- ♦ Limit and regulate housing densities, keep rural small town sense of community, incorporate (?) not sure benefits outweigh risks and costs
- ♦ Look what happened in Watkins!!
- ♦ Look what happened to Watkins when they decided to incorporate and the problems Deertrail is having. Now Byers has police protection and road service without any cost.
- ♦ Need health care! Limon and Strasburg health care should combine in Byers! May(?) Farms is an example of a resident truly interested in investing in Byers - follow their lead!
- ♦ Need more eating palces for people to get jobs, and a truck stop open all night
- ♦ Planning and zoning would be expediated (sic)
- ♦ Services provided by county are far and few between
- ♦ Some areas are ugly (railroad house) = make a 'park' parallel to RR for jogging, bikes etc. Junkyard area is eyesore.
- ♦ Stop the city will grow, but keep the big city crim and police stuff in the big city. We don't need more dictators keep them to the west. (sic)
- ♦ There seems to be a lot of problems when small towns in eastern Co. have incorporated. Latest example, Watkins.
